












PERS Employer Incentive Fund (EIF)




- PERS Employer Incentive Fund (EIF) created by State legislature in 2019
- Employers make lump-sum deposits to pay down Unfunded Actuarial Liability (UAL)
- \$100 million in matching fund available
- State matches 25% match of contribution amount
- PERS rate offset lowers PERS costs

- FY21 Proposed Budget recommendation remains \$8M





 Staff will monitor situation with hopes to deposit \$8M but at minimum will deposit \$3M, pending Council direction in fall





