Case #VAR16-0005, variance to the minimum side setbacks in the R-3 zone district at 5604 South Prescott Street, Littleton, CO

BACKGROUND: The subject property is part of the original 1890 platting for the City of Littleton and the lot is 6,250 square feet (50' wide and 125' deep) and is located within the R-3 Zone District. The minimum lot size for the R-3 Zone District is 6,500 square feet with a minimum lot width of 65' at the front setback. Structures in the R-3 Zone District must meet a 20 foot front and rear setback, and side setbacks of north/west: 5 feet, south/east: 10 feet and corner lot/side street: 10 feet. The subject property is located on the southeast corner of Powers Street and Prescott Street.

The city's zoning code requires any structure and portion thereof, not be located within any prescribed setbacks. Roof and eaves are part of structures and cannot encroach into setbacks.

There are multiple blocks of parcels in this section of the city that are non-conforming lots in size and width, and portions of older homes do appear to be located within setbacks. The applicant proposes to demolish the existing house and detached garage, and construct a new single family residence. Because of the non-conforming lot size, staff worked with the applicant and granted an Administrative Variance, which provided a 20% reduction on the side setback requirements (2' on both the north and south setbacks). The existing side yard setbacks for this property are 8 feet on the north side yard and 8 feet on the south side yard.

With this variance request, the applicant is seeking an additional reduction in setback on the north side yard of 4 more feet to allow for roof and deeper eaves, which would result in a north side setback of 4 feet.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

Section 10-11-1 (B) gives the Board of Adjustment (Board) the authority to grant variances where "due to exceptional and extraordinary circumstances, literal enforcement of the provisions of this Title will result in unnecessary hardship". No variance can be approved unless the Board finds that all of the criteria stated in Section 10-11-1 (B) have been met.

The following is an assessment of the application under the criteria for approval contained in Section 10-11-1 (B):

1. That the variance will not authorize the operation of a use other than those uses specifically listed as primary permitted uses for the zone district in which the affected property is located.

Applicant Response: R-3 zoning allows for a single family residence on lots of 6500 sf. The lot is not conforming but we are building a single family residence.

Staff Analysis: The requested variance would not allow any use other than a single family residence. This criterion is met.

2. That the variance will not alter the essential character of the neighborhood or zone in which the property is located or substantially or permanently impair the allowed use or development of adjacent property.

Applicant Response: The variance will allow us to build a house that is in accordance with other houses previously built in the neighborhood. By moving the house 2' further north of the approved minor variance it will not impair the house to the south. Moving the house closer to the setback on the north does not impair any adjacent property since it is a right of way and street.

Staff Analysis: There are a variety of houses (size, height, and setbacks) built in this neighborhood. 5604 South Prescott Street is a corner lot on the southeast corner of Powers Street and Prescott Street. The applicant is proposing to improve the existing conditions by removing a non-compliant detached garage that was built partially in right of way and they are trying to increase the distance to the adjacent property owner's house to the south that is only 4' away from the property line. It appears some relief to the north side setback to allow for roof and deeper eaves will not alter the essential character of the neighborhood. This criterion appears to be met.

3. That the variance is the minimum that will afford relief and is the least possible modification to the provision in question.

Applicant Response: All other lots allow a 35' wide house to be built. We are requesting a 34' wide house.

Staff Analysis: The R-3 Zone District has a minimum lot size of 6,500 square feet and this property is considered non-conforming with a lot size of 6,250 square feet. Structures in the R-3 Zone District must meet a 20 foot front and rear setback, and side setbacks of -north/west: 5 feet, south/east: 10 feet and corner lot/side street: 10 feet.

The subject property is a corner lot and the north side setback (along Powers Street) is 10 feet. The applicant was granted a 2 foot Administrative Variance for both the north and south side setbacks so currently the required side setbacks for this property are 8 feet on the north and 8 feet on the south. There is 10 feet of tree lawn/grass right of way before the paved street to the north of the property. The applicant is requesting an additional 4 foot reduction for the north side setback, which would result in a 4 foot setback.

Based on the nonconforming lot size and the property being a corner lot, it does appear that there is justification for a reduction in the north side setback. Lots in the R-3 Zone District that are not on a corner have a 5 foot north/west side yard setback. It appears allowing an additional 3 foot reduction in the north side setback, which would result in a 5 foot setback, is the minimum that will afford relief and still keep in character with the R-3 Zone District setback requirements.

4. That the variance will not adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare.

Applicant Response: In no way will the variance affect the public health, safety and welfare of the

neighborhood

Staff Analysis: An additional 3 foot reduction in the north side setback for the property, which is the requirement for other non-corner lots in the R-3 Zone District, does not appear to adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare of the neighborhood. Any future building permit for a single family home will still need to meet all other zoning, public works and traffic requirements.

5. That the hardship, if any, under which the variance is sought, was not created by the owner, occupant or agent of the owner of the property in question; nor was it suffered as a result of a violation of any provision of this code.

Applicant Response: The hardship was not self-created. It is the case for all west facing houses on corner lots

Staff Analysis: The lot size and width in the R-3 Zone District was not created by the applicant nor is it a result of a violation of any provision of this code. The subject property does not meet the minimum lot size for R-3. This criterion appears to be met.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

PROPOSED MOTION:

I move to approve Case#VAR16-0005, request for a variance at 5604 S. Prescott Street, be approved to allow an additional reduction of 3 feet for the north side setback, which results in a 5 foot north side yard setback, in that all of the criteria of Section 10-11-1 (B) of the Littleton City Code are met for the Board to grant approval. Approval of this application is based on the following findings of fact:

- 1. The requested variance would not allow any use other than a single family residence.
- 2. That the variance will not alter the essential character of the neighborhood or zone in which the property is located or substantially or permanently impair the allowed use or development of adjacent property.
- 3. That the variance is the minimum that will afford relief and is the least possible modification to the provision in question.
- 4. That the variance will not adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare.
- 5. That the hardship, if any, under which the variance is sought, was not created by the owner, occupant or agent of the owner of the property in question; nor was it suffered as a result of a violation of any provision of this code.

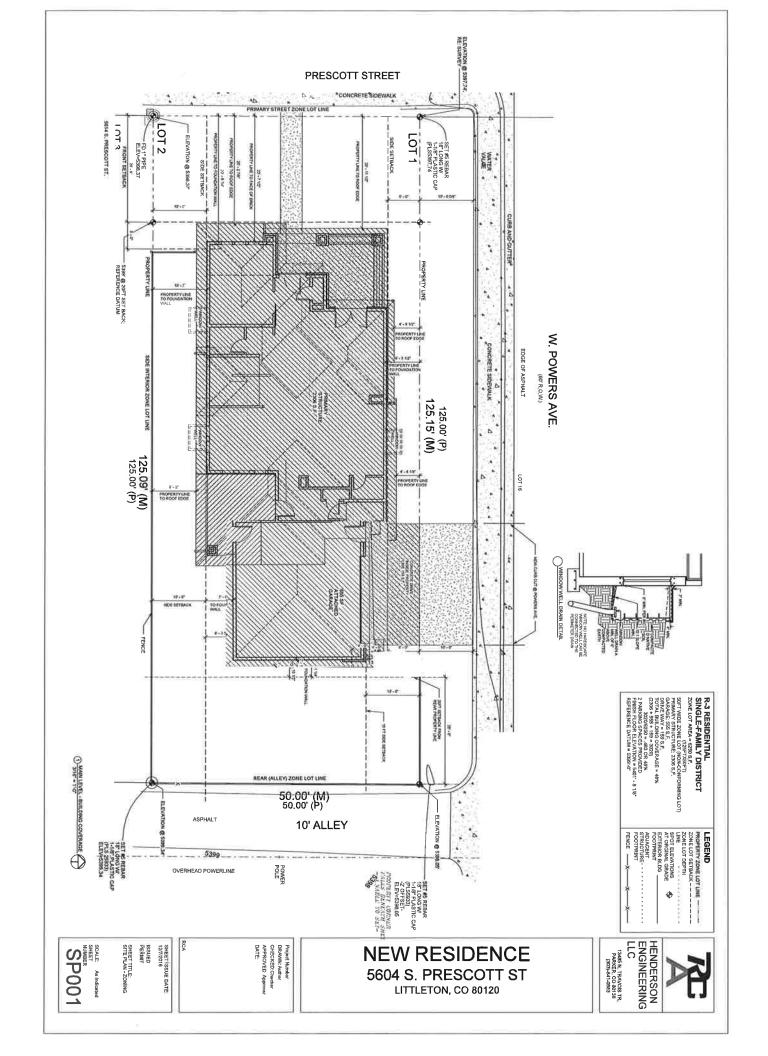

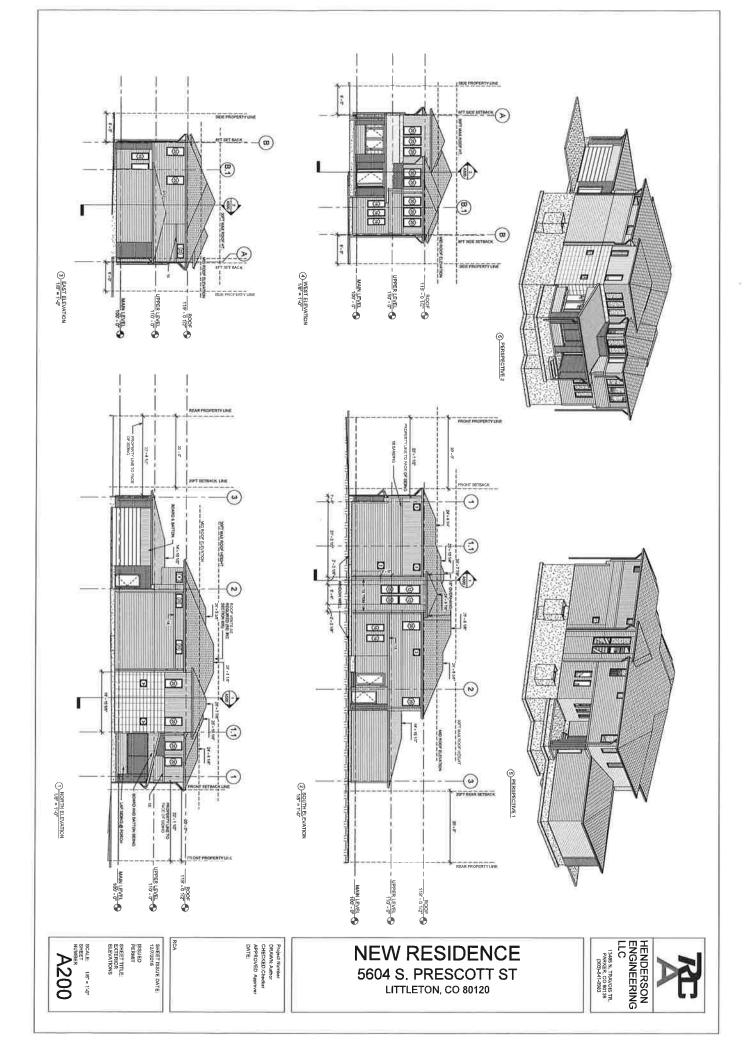

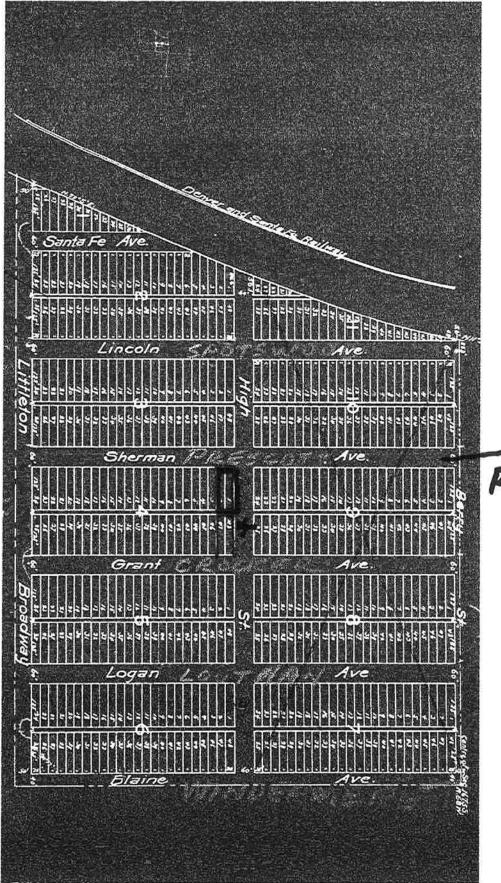




- 1. If we move the house 2' North the house setback will be 10'2" from south property line and the roof will extend 2' into the setback
- 2. The setback to the North property line will be 6'3" and the roof will be 4'4" from the property line. There is an additional 7' of right of way from the property line on the north side of the property to the street.

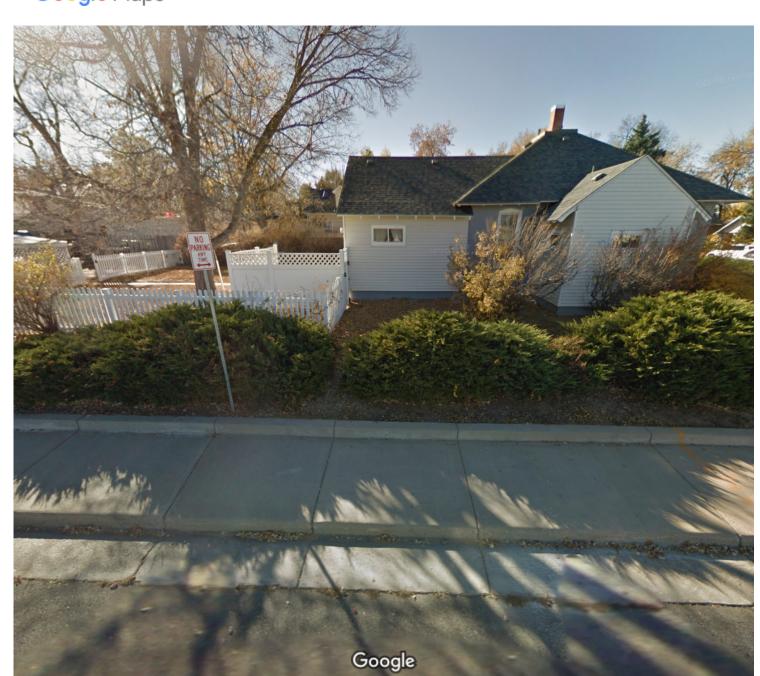
