Moved by Authority Vice Chair Cole, seconded by Authority Chair Bradish, to close the public hearing and that a resolution of the Littleton Licensing Authority be approved which grants King Solomon Liquor Inc., d/b/a King Solomon Liquor, 4760 West Mineral Avenue #30, Littleton, Colorado, a retail liquor store license contingent upon approval by the Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division and based upon the following findings of fact: (1) that notice of the hearing was properly posted and published; (2) that the applicant has possession of the premises and the premises are suitable for the requested license; (3) that the needs of the neighborhood are not now being met; (4) that it is the desire of the adult inhabitants of the neighborhood that the license be issued; (5) that existing similar liquor licenses in the designated neighborhood are not adequate; and (6) that the applicant is a person of good moral character, record and reputation.

Moved by Authority Chair Bradish, seconded by Authority Member O'Dell, that based on the foregoing evidence and testimony concerning factors in mitigation and aggravation, I move that the liquor license of Vasilios Frangiskakis, d/b/a Old Mill Brewery, 5798 South Rapp Street be suspended for a period of 14 days with 7 days to be held in abeyance for a one year period and that during such period there be no further violation of the Colorado Liquor Code and associated regulations and/or the Littleton City Code and that notices of such suspension be posted in and outside of the licensed premises in accordance with Liquor Code Regulation 47-600(F) and that the suspension be served beginning March 11, through March 17, 2015.
